TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to certify that the Joint Regional Communications Centre (JRCC) is a Division of the CARICOM Implementation Agency for Crime and Security (IMPACS) which has been designated an Institution of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM). IMPACS is located in Trinidad and Tobago and its Barbados office, the JRCC, is located in Barbados.

As an Institution of the Caribbean Community, IMPACS and the JRCC are entitled to the privileges and immunities as provided for in the Protocol on the Privileges and Immunities of the Caribbean Community, to which Barbados is a signatory.

The JRCC is therefore entitled, inter alia, to the duty-free importation of equipment for the Centre, to hold funds, gold or currency of any kind, operate accounts in any currency and to freely transfer these funds from one country to another.

The Ministry encourages your facilitation of the operations of the JRCC in the manner described above.
