BRIDGETOWN, BARBADOS July 21st, 2025 – With **Crop Over 2025** soon to wrap up in grand style, Barbados is immediately shifting into full gear to host the highly anticipated **CARIFESTA XV,** taking place from **22–31 August 2025.**

The island is proud to announce that it is **ready and fully equipped** to welcome the Caribbean and the world for 10 unforgettable days of **music**, **art**, **dance**, **fashion**, **food**, **film**, **and cultural dialogue**.

"Barbados is the place to be this August for CARIFESTA XV, which will be a beautiful melting pot of Caribbean cultures, foods, fashion, performances and visual arts," says the **Chief Executive Officer of the Barbados Tourism Marketing Inc. CARIFESTA XV is the 15th edition of the **Caribbean Festival of Arts**, the region's largest and most prestigious multidisciplinary cultural event. It features 10 days of music, dance, fashion, film, visual arts, theatre, food, and cultural symposia.

2. When and where is CARIFESTA XV taking place? The festival will take place in Barbados from 22 to 31 August 2025, with events scheduled across multiple national venues, public spaces, and cultural districts.

3. What is the theme of CARIFESTA XV?

The theme is "Caribbean Roots... Global Excellence." It highlights our deep regional cultural ties while celebrating the Caribbean's rising global influence in the creative industries.

4. Which Countries are featured at CARIFESTA XV?

Over 25 countries are participating, including CARICOM Member States and international delegations from Ghana, Brazil, Colombia, and Cuba. The festival offers both FREE and PAID Events that are open to the public and ideal for culture lovers, creatives, buyers, entrepreneurs, and tourists.

5. Why is CARIFESTA important?

It fosters **regional unity**, supports the **Orange Economy**, and provides a **global platform for Caribbean talent**. It's also a driver for cultural tourism, economic activity, and youth engagement across the region.

10. What is the Grand Market at CARIFESTA XV? It is the largest cultural market in CARIFESTA history, spanning over 45,000 sq. ft. at Waterford Place, running from 23–31 August. It includes five zones: Fashion, Home & Décor, Wellness, Literature, and Gourmet Foods.

11. What makes the Grand Market unique?

It's a blend of **culture and commerce**, offering regional Micro Small and Medium Enterprises a platform to connect with **international buyers**, access **sales assistance**, and leverage **e-commerce** for global reach. This is ideal for Caribbean Entrepreneurs

12. What are the daily hours of operation?

The Grand Market will run daily from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., with live performances, country showcases, and culinary exhibitions throughout the day.

13. Will there be food at the market?

Yes. The **Caribbean Eat Street** will feature **24 food booths** representing diverse regional cuisine, from Jamaican jerk to Bajan Cou Cou & flying fish and vegan Ital dishes, Haitian Joumou Soup, Trini Doubles, Antiguan Ducana, just to name a few...and all the delightful flavours of the region


14. Are there business development opportunities for creatives?


