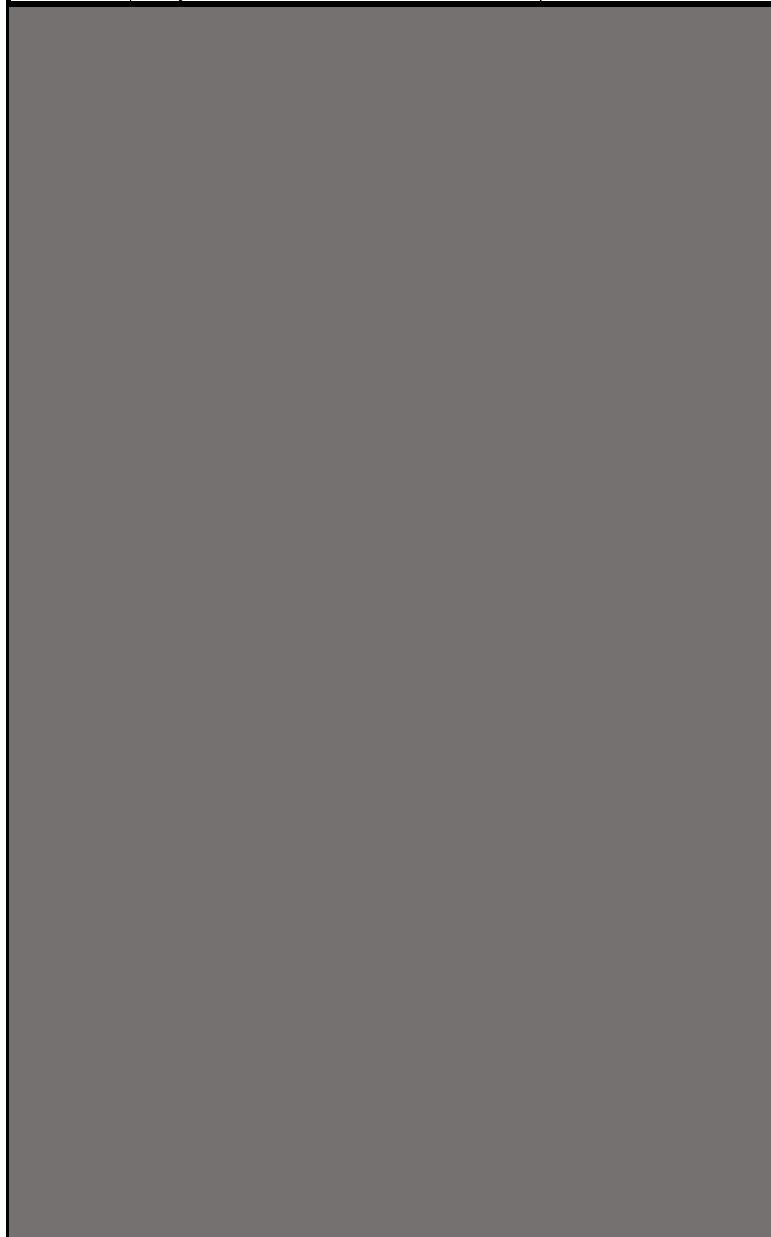
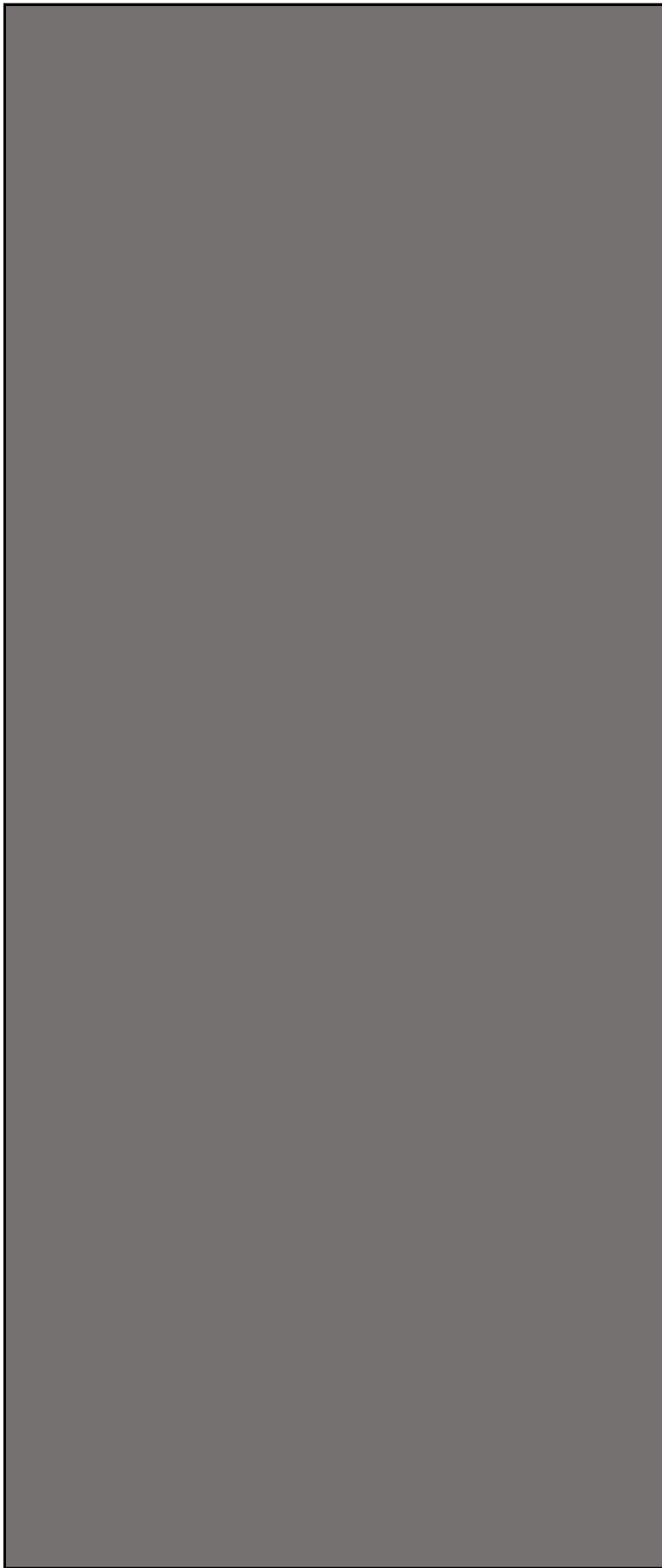

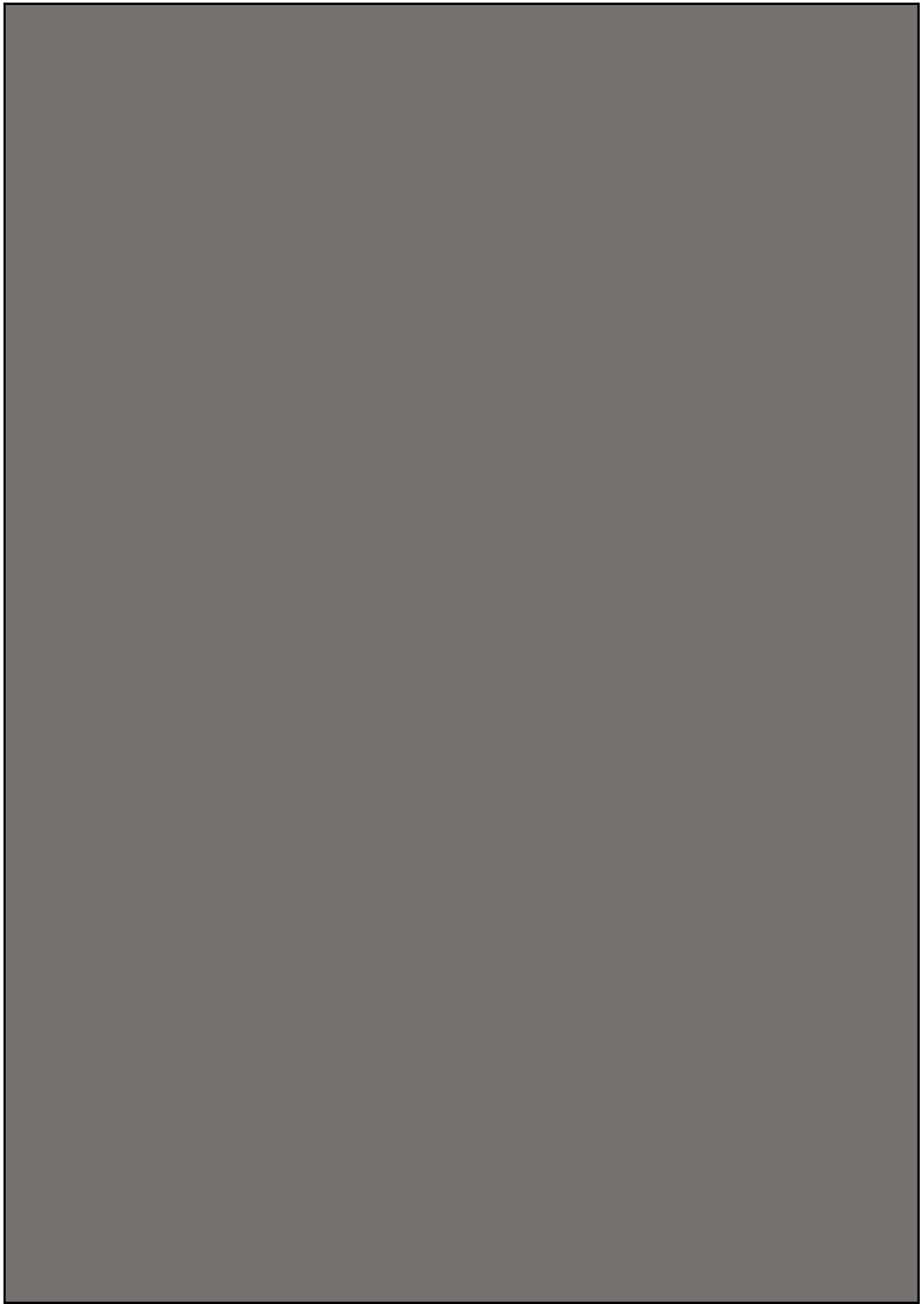

All personnel in position at Lyndhurst Funeral Home, Mt Pleasant Memorial Gardens , St Peter's Parish Church & Battaleys Church. Gun Carriage in position at Battaleys.	As outlined in details column
Procession Departs Lyndhurst Funeral Home for Battaleys.	As outlined in details column
Chief of Staff and Commissioner arrive at Battaleys.	Battaleys
Parade forms up and prepares to begin the procession.	Battaleys
Procession from Lyndhurst Funeral Home arrives at Battaleys. Route Liners in position at Queen's Street.	Battaleys
Casket transferred from hearse to Gun Carriage.	Battaleys
All marching troops with Gun Carriage and family cars depart Battaleys	Battaleys

Members of the BDF and RBPF will march forward and present wreaths to be laid. Mrs Arthur will lay the first wreath, followed by the PM, then other family members and the Diplomatic Corps. Wreath laying ends.
